

2019 COONAWARRA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Colour

Dark crimson with mauve edge.

Aroma

Initially ripe plum and blackberry conserve, then star anise, mint and bramble. Great presence and complexity.

Palate

Well structured palate of rich ripe grape tannins supported and elaborated with french oak framework. Cassis and plum, cigar box and cocoa.

Food matching

Classically styled Cabernet, is well suited to a classic match of scotch fillet or grilled mushrooms.

Cellaring

This wine is offering great vibrancy and freshness now, but will also develop beautifully with age for the next 10 years and beyond.

Wine Summary

Cabernet Sauvignon is Coonawarra's pre-eminent grape variety. Parcels of premium fruit are selected, fermented and then aged in French oak barrels to produce this full bodied and richly flavoured wine.
